

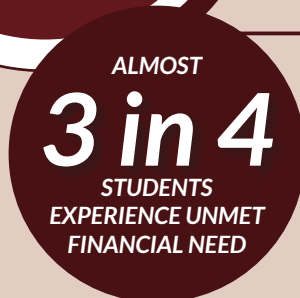
TODAY'S COLLEGE STUDENTS

Maybe you're working, spending more time on the job than in school. Almost 3 in 4 students work, and many others are trying to find work. (tinyurl.com/WorkingStudents)



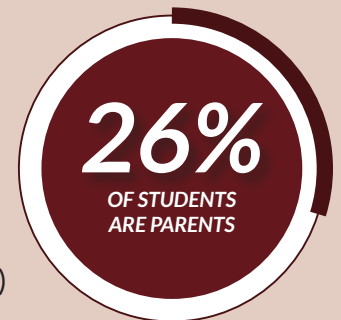
